



Caribou Recovery Discussion Postponed

January 8, 2018 – The Resource Municipalities Coalition – Caribou Recovery Discussion scheduled for January 11, 2019 with presentations from the Provincial Government and First Nations has been postponed.

The purpose of this discussion was to allow Provincial Government and First Nation leaders an opportunity to speak to the Caribou protection, a roundtable discussion based on the Plan - looking to find a balance between protecting the Central Caribou herds and economic development, followed by a panel discussion with Government, First Nations and other stakeholders on the findings during the round table session – providing recommendations for Private Members Bill for our MLA's and MP to address these processes.

At this time, without a draft agreement in place, the Federal Government, Provincial Government prefer to not discuss this issue. The West Moberly and Sauleau First Nations are willing to have an open discussion with stakeholders as soon as all sides are willing. With this in mind, the Coalition felt it best to postpone the Caribou Recovery Discussion.

The Resource Municipalities Coalition is working to develop Private Members Bills that focuses on process with respect to future dialogue concerning issues that impact our region and continuing to work with Government, First Nations and industries to promote the interests of our communities.
